

## **DARITE VILLAGE HALL DISABLED ACCESS**

General access to the village through the country lanes should not be of concern to adapted small vans.

The village and indeed, The hall is situated on an unlit single track tarmacked road. The rear of the hall has an access lane which is unmaintained at present.

The road leads to a dead end, however there are a few turn round points.

During the larger events (Meadow Fayre etc) we do have occasional use of the School car park which is on a slope.

On road parking spaces are few, but there is an area to the front end of the hall that can be used to drop off people or unload wheelchairs.

A small, unlit, uphill lane to the rear is unsuitable for solo wheelchair users. Help from two or three people is recommended to maintain safe progress to the rear fire exit of the hall.

The hall itself is accessible from the following routes on foot with assistance,

1. From the road, granite steps to the front with hand rails, and up a smaller set of 3 steps to the main hall porch.
2. From the rear track for more able walkers, there is a small path round to the front set of 3 steps to the main hall porch.
3. From the rear track, wheel chair access to the fire exit of the main hall.

Once inside we have a spacious disabled toilet with handrails.
